#### 5. TRASH REMINDERS – be a good neighbor and help remind others too.

- Please do not put any animal waste in the restroom trash cans as it quickly impacts the smell of the restrooms. Sergio and Sheila works hard to keep the restrooms clean and smelling good. Please find an outside trash can for animal waste.
- Please remember to break down your boxes before placing them in the recycling carts.
- No human waste is allowed in the garbage, recycling or compost carts; we have professional recyclers who are helping us every day to comply with County regulations and this creates a health hazard and violation.

#### 6. SAFETY & SECURITY

- Please do not use trash cans or paper towels to prop open restroom doors as this allows those not associated with the marina to access our facilities.
- Do not allow others to walk in a gate or bathroom behind you. We take security seriously and track who has been in and out with key fobs, for increased security.
- Overton Security has their own vehicle and golf cart now with new strobe lights. If you need their assistance, call **510-791-7380** or **800-343-1901**. The security patrol has been increased during critical hours as we work on additional potential security measures.
- Keep kayaks, bikes, fuel, and other items off the docks. Nothing should be on the docks and fingers except your steps. Let's stay safe together!
