GATE 8 LAUNDRY UPDATE – We are still waiting for the arrival of the new windows for the laundry room and restrooms. If you prefer to use laundry pods, please put them **in** the machine with your clothes. Using pods in the liquid dispenser causes flooding!

INSURANCE – A friendly reminder to send in your new insurance information since we need this to be updated yearly! Thank you.

GATE SECURITY – Please make sure to meet your guests at the gate, and DO NOT let others follow you through the gate unless you know them. There have been suspicious individuals on the docks who have been reported to the office. Let's be kind but look out for each other at the same time. If you have a guest coming, please greet them at the gate and escort them in. If you see something suspicious or observe criminal activity, please contact the Alameda City Police at (510) 337-8340. For emergency calls please call 911. The police have asked that people who observe such activity call them directly rather than filtering the calls through our office.

BIKES – Three bike storage lockers are available at Gate 10 extension parking lot for either daily use or nightly use on a first-come, first-serve basis.
